A critical aspect of the session was educating children about safe and unsafe touches. Through age-appropriate language and examples, they were taught to recognize and differentiate between appropriate and inappropriate physical contact.







To reinforce learning, role-play exercises were conducted where children practiced assertive communication skills and learned how to say "no" in situations where they feel uncomfortable or threatened.

Moving forward, Agape Blessed Foundation Trust plans to conduct regular follow-up sessions and workshops on child safety to ensure that children continue to build upon the knowledge and skills acquired during this session.

Fun Activity at Lahori Gate

Children were provided with art supplies such as crayons, markers, colored pencils, and papers. They enthusiastically participated in drawing, coloring, and crafting activities, expressing their creativity and imagination.

Volunteers from Agape Blessed Foundation Trust conducted storytelling sessions, captivating the children with engaging tales and moral lessons. This activity not only entertained the children but also fostered their love for storytelling and reading.



Session on Child Labour Day

Furthermore, discussions delved into the underlying socioeconomic factors perpetuating the cycle of child labor, shedding light on the need for comprehensive interventions at both grassroots and policy levels.

One of the key highlights of the event was the poster-making activity, which engaged children from GB Road in creative expression. Through vibrant colors and poignant imagery, these young artists conveyed powerful messages advocating for the eradication of child labor and the promotion of education as a pathway to a brighter future. - 4. Identifying Trusted Adults: The students were guided in identifying trusted adults in their lives whom they could confide in if they encountered an unsafe situation. Parents, teachers, school counselors, and family members were highlighted as potential sources of support.
- 5. Reporting Procedures: The procedures for reporting unsafe touches were explained clearly. Students were informed about the importance of reporting such incidents to a trusted adult and the steps that would be taken to ensure their safety and well-being.

Interactive Activities: The session included age-appropriate interactive activities such as group discussions, and the opportunity for students to ask questions. These activities were designed to engage the students and reinforce the concepts presented during the session.

Feedback and Impact: The students exhibited active participation and were attentive throughout the session. The interactive activities provided opportunities for them to express their thoughts and clarify doubts. Feedback from both students and school staff was positive, indicating that the session was informative and engaging.

Child Sexual Abuse Prevention Session
