Established in 2017, the Trust works closely with District Child Protection Units, Child Welfare Committees, NGO and local stakeholders across South, South East, and Central Delhi to ensure holistic development and protection of children, especially those in vulnerable situations.

Our key focus areas include menstrual hygiene awareness, psycho-social support for children under the POCSO Act, educational mentoring, and capacity-building programs for caregivers and law enforcement personnel. Through projects like *Empowering the Young Minds*, Agape provides academic support, life skills, and joyful learning experiences to children from underserved communities. We believe in equality, dignity, and compassion – celebrating every festival, milestone, and small victory with the children and families we serve.

Session on Strengthening Roots: Celebrating Bonds

On 6th April 2025, Agape Blessed Foundation Trust conducted a special session titled **"Strengthening Roots: Celebrating Bonds"** with the children under its care. The session was organized with the purpose of teaching children the importance of family ties and the value of relationships, addressing the growing concern that children today are becoming less attached to their families due to the influence of modern lifestyles. The session began with an open and interactive discussion where children were encouraged to share their thoughts about their families and what family means to them. This was followed by storytelling activities, where inspirational stories emphasizing the love, support, and strength that families provide were shared.

To make the session more engaging, children participated in a creative activity where they made "Family Trees" and shared fond memories about their family members. A reflection exercise was also organized where children wrote letters or drew pictures for their parents or guardians, expressing their feelings of love, gratitude, and appreciation. Stationery Distribution Drive

The session also included a group discussion segment where members contributed valuable insights for shaping the network's Annual Plan for 2025-26, with special attention on areas such as parental support programs, livelihood linkages, access to entitlements, mental health support, and follow-up mechanisms.



International Yoga Day Celebration – 21st June 2025

On **International Yoga Day**, Agape Blessed Foundation Trust organized a special yoga session for the children under the *Empowering the Young Minds* project on 21st June 2025. The celebration aimed to promote the importance of physical and mental well-being through the ancient practice of yoga.

This was followed by a discussion on different emotions, where children were encouraged to express feelings such as happiness, sadness, anger, and fear through facial expressions and verbal cues. To reinforce these learnings in a joyful way, the session concluded with a finger-painting activity, allowing children to express themselves freely through colors and textures. The interactive session not only helped enhance the children's understanding of personal safety and emotional awareness but also gave them a platform for creative self-expression.



Session on First Aid on 27th June
